
GAMES CHILDREN PLAY AROUND THE WORLD

SUGGESTED USE

These games have simple rules and are easy to set up, and they include both indoor and outdoor activities. Some are more suited for larger groups, such as a class, and some for smaller groupings or pairs. Each would make a good recess activity, or you could set up stations for the various games in a "field day" kind of arrangement.

When introducing the activities to the students, try to get them to recognize that none of the games require elaborate or expensive equipment. That's because one thing children everywhere have in common is imagination and the ability to entertain themselves with what they have on hand. Ask the students to share some of the simple games they play with their friends and offer an example or two from your own childhood.
